Overview:

The Foundation awarded the PCC £2,500 to restore and make safe the access area of ancient stone path and steps leading to front door of the church hall, which was severely worn, unsafe and unfit for purpose due to excessive wear from 150 years of use. The funding also purchased a portable ramp for the main entrance.

The work made safe the access way to the church hall, particularly for the elderly, infirm and those with impaired mobility, as well as other church members and visitors for church meetings, meetings of other groups and those visiting for social and educational purposes.
