Overview:

The charity of John Corner (St. Hilda's Almshouses) provide housing for vulnerable parish residents who struggle to qualify for other forms of social housing in the parish, people living in unsuitable accommodation, or those living with family in cramped conditions. This means people can remain in a place where they feel safe, and do not have to move away from their support networks of family and friends, to become lonely and isolated.

The Charity of John Corner (St. Hilda's Almshouses) was awarded £5,000 to help complete the renovation of a derelict property to provide quality living accommodation for vulnerable parish residents.

Phase III of the renovation project has provided a further two units of accommodation for vulnerable families.
