Overview:

Fylingdales Cricket and Football Club has over 70 active adult members and caters for senior and junior cricket and football teams. All of the players raise their own funds and look after their ground themselves, while the club charges no match fees. The club was previously short of storage space since its pavilion burnt down.

The Foundation awarded a grant of £3,500 to the club to develop its range of facilities, including upgrading playing surfaces, practice areas and customer amenities. These improved facilities will see an increase in membership and will develop the clubs range of facilities in an area with few opportunities in the way of organised sport or clubs, especially for young people.
