Overview:

Scarborough and District Scout Council caters for over 600 active members of the Scouting movement in Scarborough and Whitby. Staff at the council have completed a three-phase project to undertake the redevelopment of their camping and residential facilities at Birch Hall campsite on the edge of the North York Moors. The site previously consisted of two very basic huts with limited accommodation and sleeping room.

£5,000 was awarded to the council to contribute to the first phase of the project – the development of its toilet and washing block, including male, female and disabled toilets and washing and showering facilities – which will serve all local members of the Scouting movement as well as Scouts from further afield.
